



Basic HMT Voice Commands

Basic Navigation (Can be used at any time)

"*Navigate Home*" - Goes to home screen with 3 circle icons.

"*Navigate Back*" - used to go back to the previous menu (Any App)

"*My Controls*" – Brings up My Controls Shortcuts

"*My Notification*" – Brings up App Notifications

"*Show Help*" – Brings up list of commands to be used on the active screen

When in **My Programs**,

"*App Name*" – Opens the specific App

Alternatively you can say "Select Item #" " to bring up the same app.

Example: Say "About Device" or say "Select Item 1"

When in **My Camera** app,

"Take Photo" - Takes photo and stores on the device

"Start Video" - Starts Recording of Video

"Stop Recording" - Stops Recording of Video

"Manual Focus" – Turns on manual focus for camera, say "manual focus again while pointing camera at the item you wish to focus on to adjust focus"

"Auto Focus" – Turns on auto focus on the camera (default setting)

“Change Ratio” – Changes Camera ratio from 4:3 to 16:9 (repeat “Change Ratio” to revert to previous setting)

“Flashlight On” – Turns on the flashlight

“Flashlight Off” Turns off the flashlight

“Zoom level “1-5” – Adjusts the zoom level. “1” being the default, “5” being fully zoomed in to the device”

When in **My Files** App,

“Select Item Number #”- Selects the item # you want to view (Most recent items 1-4 are displayed on the My Files screen)

“My Photos” – Opens **My Photos** app

“My Media” – Opens **My Media** (video) app

“My Documents – Opens My Documents app

“Scan Bookmark” - ????

When in **My Photos/My Media/My Documents**,

“Select Item Number “#” – Opens the photo/video/document with that #. Alternatively you can say the name of the photo to open.

Example: “Select item Number 1” or “Forest” (Original photo is Forest.jpg, Item # 1)

“Edit Mode” – Allows you to select one or multiple images/videos/documents

When in **Edit Mode (Photos, Media, Documents)**,

“Select Item Number “#” – Selects the photo with that #. Alternatively you can say the name of the photo to select it.

Note* - You can select multiple photos/videos/documents at once.

“Cancel Edit” – Leaves edit mode

“Delete Selected” – Deleted the selected photos/videos/documents on the screen

When a Photo/Documents has been **Open**,

"Zoom level 1-5" - Zooms in on a particular section of the image or pdf. Zoom level 5 is the highest, zoom level 1 is fully zoomed out or no zoom.

When panning around the screen with your head you can say “Freeze Document” to freeze the screen on the section of the **photo/document** you are looking at. To control the document again, say “Control Document”

When viewing a **Video** (Automatically starts playing) ,

“Video Pause” – Pauses the video

“Video Play” – Plays the video

“Video Rewind” – Rewinds video the beginning.

“Select Volume “1-5” – Increases or decreases the Volume to the level specified

“Select Brightness “1-5” – Increases or decreases the Brightness to the level specified

When in **My Controls**,

“Set Bluetooth” – Turns Bluetooth on or off

“Set Wireless Networks” – Goes the WiFi Network Selection Screen

“Mouse Enable”/“Mouse Disable” – Turns the mouse cursor on or off. When using the mouse, say “Mouse Click” to select the item that you have highlighted with the cursor.

“Hide Show Help”/“Display Show Help” – Turns on/off the **i Show Help** menu item in the bottom right hand corner of the screen.

“Disable auto mute”/“Enable Auto Mute” - ????????

“Lock Screen Rotation”/“Unlock Screen Rotation” – Locks or unlocks the screen from auto rotating when you turn rotate the headset.

“Flashlight On”/“Flashlight Off” – Turns the flashlight on or off

“Bluetooth Mode Master” - ????

“Cloud Dictation” – ?????

“More Settings” – Takes you to the Android Settings menu”

“Select Volume “1-5” – Increases or decreases the Volume to the level specified

“Select Brightness “1-5” – Increases or decreases the Brightness to the level specified

When in **Text Field**,

“Scan Code” – Brings up QR barcode scanner. After entering the text into the **Realwear Companion** app (Phone/Tablet), scan the generated QR code bring the text into the headset text field.
